

Dr. S. Ramkumar, aged 41, is an Endocrinologist and Diabetologist based in Chennai, India. He holds an MBBS, MD, DM, and DrNB in Endocrinology and is a Member of the National Academy of Medical Sciences (MNAMS). He is also a Fellow of the European Committee of Sexual Medicine and has completed a Clinical Fellowship in Diabetes from Auckland, New Zealand. After completing his MD, Dr. Ramkumar secured the first rank in the AIIMS entrance examination and worked at the Department of Endocrinology at AIIMS for three years. He then joined Apollo Hospitals (Main and Children's), where he continues to practice. Additionally, he has received specialized training from renowned organizations like the European Society for Paediatric Endocrinology (ESPE) in Israel, the Asia Pacific Paediatric Endocrine Society (APPES) in Indonesia, and the International Society for Pediatric and Adolescent Diabetes (ISPAD) in Italy.

With over 10 years of experience since completing his DM in 2013, Dr. Ramkumar has worked extensively in both academic and clinical settings. He previously served as a Senior Assistant Professor in the Department of Endocrinology at Madras Medical College, and as a consultant at various private hospitals and government institutions, including the Institute of Child Health and Rajiv Gandhi Government Hospital in Chennai. Currently, Dr. Ramkumar is affiliated with Apollo Hospitals (Main and Children's) and runs a separate clinic for pediatric endocrinology - Paedendo Clinic.

Dr. Ramkumar has made significant contributions to pediatric endocrinology through his research and publications. He has authored numerous articles in renowned medical journals, covering topics such as premenopausal hirsutism, type 2 diabetes in children, and ectopic insulin-secreting neuroendocrine tumors. His work has been instrumental in advancing the field, and he has guided MD and DNB students on various research projects related to childhood obesity and short stature. Dr. Ramkumar is also a respected speaker, having presented at several national and international endocrinology conferences. During his time in government service, he played a crucial role in including Growth Hormone therapy through the Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation (TNMSC), helping many children receive free treatment.

His extensive training includes a fellowship in Diabetes insulin pump therapy at Auckland City Hospital, New Zealand, and additional certification in insulin pump training in India. In 2019, he also attended the European School of Sexual Medicine (ESSM) in Budapest, Hungary. Dr. Ramkumar has been recognized for his clinical excellence, receiving several prestigious awards, including the Dr. Balagopal Raju Gold Medal, First Prize in Endocrine Quiz at Amrita Institute of Medical Sciences (2013), and the AV Gandhi Award for Excellence in Endocrinology (2014).

Dr. Ramkumar is an active member of several professional organizations, including the Indian Society of Paediatric and Adolescent Endocrinology (ISPAE), the Endocrine Society of India (ESI), the Endocrine Society of Tamil Nadu (ESTN), the Indian Society of Bone and Mineral Research (ISBMR), and the Asian Pacific Pediatric Endocrine Society (APPES). He has also participated in numerous international conferences, including the European Association for the Study of Diabetes (EASD) 2018 in Barcelona, the Global Scientific Exchange Program in Athens, Greece, and the Emirates Diabetes and Endocrine Conference in Dubai.
