COURSE OBJECTIVE:

To develop a pool of certified Pediatric Diabetes Educators with expertise in ambulatory management of diabetes in children, adolescents and young adults, by imparting theoretical and practical knowledge and skills, by experienced, and learned faculty from ISPAE.

COURSE MODALITIES:

Structured online training course consisting of 17 teaching sessions, 7 feedback sessions, 4 revision classes, and an exit exam.
